## J3. Operational Matters.

- 4. Target development of threat networks in consultation, liaison and deconfliction with ISAF TFs in KABUL has occurred this week. TF 81 conducted a number of tasks in and around KABUL as part of target development. TF81 continues to focus on operations with the Ministry of Interior (MOI) and National Directorate of Security (NDS) for short notice tasks in support of CRU (TF24) through the disruption of insurgent movement, leadership and supply throughout Kabul and its surrounding provinces.
- 5. TF81 will continue to conduct partnered influence, interdiction and disruption operations throughout Kabul and its surrounding provinces. Concurrently TF81 is working to develop a strong and enduring partnership with ANSF and GIRoA.

- 16. TF81 has restructured its CRU training plan to account for the approach of Ramadan. Training has now ceased at the PSR(S)1 camp and will not resume until after Ramadan and the September elections. In camp training will occur with CRU in KABUL.
- 17. In response to the IED incident in BAMYAN province, TF81 provided to support the NZPRT as required and prepositioned this team in BAGHRAM. In the end this support was not required and the team returned to Camp Warehouse. ## INTELLIGENCE SUMMARY TF81-044 08 AUG 2010

### SUMMARY OF THREAT ACTIVITY OVER PERIOD 02 - 08 AUG 10.

- 1. (ISAF SECRET) Reporting this week indicates increased threats to government officials through both direct attacks and kidnapping. Furthermore in the build up to Ramadan reporting indicates that INS may be staging on the peripheral of KABUL with the intent of conducting attacks during the Ramadan period.
- 2. (ISAF SECRET) S2 COMMENT: It is likely that attacks against key GIRoA facilities and personnel will increase in the build up to the 18 SEP 10 parliamentary elections. It is likely that the INS intent is to generate significant media coverage and promote the insurgent propaganda campaign END COMMENT
