A number of moving parts around the battlespace this week with team members at PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 and on various tasks. looked after the PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 for a couple of days. There has been ltd ISAF movt around (less us) KBL due to ANSF Col shooting, Victory Day, TB claims of the spring offensive. On Wed night the Ambassadors hosted a farewell dinner for PSR(IC)3, PSR(S)1 at his residence.

Operationally its been quiet for us. PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 remains in MOI custody under questioning. Tonight we were about to launch a unilateral security op (ie no CRU) in support of a PSR(S)1 led arrest task to the 20km West of the

city but at the 11<sup>th</sup> hour NDS decided it was not resourced to operate out of the city (our purpose for being there to provide the security bubble to enable their arrest). This is now cancelled and they will wait to the OBJ moves into KBL city. Key outcomes this week:

- Signed letter from PSR(S)1 DepMin Sec PSR(S)1
  delivered to US Project Engr to keep the PSR(S)1, PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 alive.
- IJC FRAGO for PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 with FUOPS staff awaiting final approval (now a short waiting game).
- movement and limited buy in from CRU on the Training and Manning conferences.
- Spt of Comd Op Planning Mod (COP-M) to be extended to ISU and PSR(S)1 students.

I had my first office call with PSR(S)1, PSR(IC)3 It was positive and fairly brief. He rates the TF and mentioned just keep on doing what we can. Understands completely the reduction in numbers. He's decisively engaged with RC E and PSR(S)1 intent to build a highway (may of started?) through PSR(S)1, PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3

trg area and trying to unfuck that. Its taking up a disproportionate amount of his time. PSR(S)1

To that end PSR(S)1, PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 and PSR(S)1, PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 taking over as PSR(S)1 Trg Centre Proj Offr) have both strongly encouraged, at PSR(S)1 recommendation, that NZ (ie JFNZ initially inform) then either PSR(S)1 or DSO when across at NSHQ conference physically visit SHAPE/NSHQ and liaise with the PSR(S)1 rep to secure the PSR(S)1, PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 appointment. Noting that PSR(sen)1 is currently flagged the J7 (that doesn't exist at the moment).

:. Importantly, the PSR(S)1 slot is approved and comes into being on 1 Jul 11. Whereas the PSR(S)1 is only being bid for in the next round of NATO/ISAF manning/bidding for Crisis Establishments (CE) which if/when approved won't become effective until 1 Jul 12. PSR(S)1 have bid for the J3 but have got no one in it. NZ could secure the PSR(S)1 psn as a Voluntary Contributing Nation (VCN) while PSR(Sen)1 just keeps on doing what he's doing. It will be a paper move as opposed to a job shift. This work has the added benefit of a night in BELGUIM to achieve this.

To that end DSO do you have any indicative timelines for your visit to Poland or here?

BAMYAN/BAGLAN: I have attached a copy of the email between and I so you know what I am thinking here and some background. The attach includes the draft/IJC FRAGO.

That's pretty much it. I'll send a partnering story board to you and the PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 separately. Other than that I have a couple of manning discussion points that I'll raise in a separate mail with the CO.
