## Ops Summary -

A FRAGO authorising an OPS BOX PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 has been approved by ISAF SOF/IJC. BLUF: This allows the activation of an Ops Box for ISAF SOF (TF954) to conduct focused tgt of NZ strat tgts on receipt of actionable int.

RC-N PSR(S)1 has conducted another couple of DDO's and today a KS that probably killed OBJ MUESIL (Qari MUSA) of the TWB Threat Gp and directly linked to atks on PRT.

Also, on 21 may in a meeting between CO NZPRT and a couple of sources they advised that OBJ NOVA (NEHMATULLAH) is currently detained in PEK, BAGHLAN. OBJ NOVA was responsible for Lt O'Donnels death and there is talk of some of his cronies raising 50K to get him out of detention. **SNO meeting with the Ambassador tomorrow to talk with him about exerting some pressure for OBJ NOVA to remain in custody and be brought to trial for his role in Lt O'Donnels death.** 

It is likely that the increased operational tempo is due to:

- PSR(S)1
- Increased exposure of the threat Gps by PRT and TF954.
- Expanded ops by PSR(S)1

- PSR(S)2, PSR(S)3 Have remained on MOI directed standby in Kabul this week. CRU PSR(S)1 led a partnered operation with TF954 and CTP.
