

Government Inquiry into Operation Burnham Public Hearing Module 4 Monday 16 September – Friday 20 September 2019

Outline of proceedings

Venue: The Thorndon Hotel, 24 Hawkestone Street, Thorndon, Wellington

Public Hearing Module 4 will examine the public statements made by the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) and the advice it provided ministers in relation to the issue of civilian casualties resulting from Operation Burnham. This is outlined in Minute No 19.

The Inquiry will hear from 12 witnesses who are current and former NZDF personnel.

Witnesses will be cross-examined on behalf of the Inquiry by Counsel Assisting, Kristy McDonald QC and Andru Isac QC. One counsel, Davey Salmon, will have up to 30 minutes to conduct supplementary cross examination of each witness for non-Crown core participants following Counsel Assisting. Counsel for NZDF may also re-examine each witness.
