### AMENDMENT TO OP WĀTEA RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

- 1. The purpose of this note is to request your endorsement of an amendment to the current OP WĀTEA rules of engagement (ROE) relating to search and seizure. The supporting ROE request I have received from OP WĀTEA describes the existing ROE search and seizure provisions as "narrow", and submits that this limitation does not currently permit TF 81 to effectively exercise necessary security and control measures when conducting operations.
- 2. The ROE request is confined to a proposed amendment to ROES (Seizure of Property), and a proposed new ROEAB expanding the authority to search to include search of property. The effect of the changes would be to expand the powers of search and seizure to contexts where the property or item to be searched and seized is not directly related to a person or persons. This would include search and seizure of abandoned property or property that has no clear owner.
- 3. I do not see any legal obstacle to this proposed change. The powers of search and seizure being exercised by coalition forces comply with best operational practice. The ability to search and seize is consistent with the authority the UN Security Council has given ISAF under Chapter 7 of the Charter to use all necessary measures to fulfil its mandate. This authority would extend to include the searching and seizing of property if necessary for mission accomplishment. Further, from a purely pragmatic perspective, expanding the ROE to permit the search and seizure of "ownerless" property is unlikely to give rise to the existence of a "victim" or aggrieved party that may wish to take action against ISAF or TF 81.
- 4. I do not regard this proposal as being contentious. I believe the proposed change will be met with the full support and endorsement of ISAF.
- 5. It is my belief that the proposed changes will enhance TF 81's ability to successfully prosecute and achieve its mission. If you agree with these amendments, it is recommended you endorse the following ROE to replace the existing OP WĀTEA ROE and add a new ROE AB and seek the approval of the Prime Minister to do the same:



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- S Seizure of any property is permitted:
  - a. when necessary for mission accomplishment; or
  - when in the possession of a person who is detained if no member of the CRU or ANSF is present to effect the seizure.

AMPN/1/ Seizure will normally be necessary for mission accomplishment when the property to be seized has or could be used in a hostile act or demonstration of hostile intent.

- AB Search of any property is permitted:
  - a. when necessary for mission accomplishment; or
  - b. when in the possession of a person who is detained if no member of the CRU or ANSF is present to conduct the search.
