

LEGAL CHECKLIST AND PROCEDURES

CO	NOP PROCEDURE (PRE-OP)	Checked
1.	Establish type of target/operation as this will determine COA and any subsequent advice and/or reporting: a. ISAF-led / ANSF partnered target;	
	b. OEF/OGA led (with ANSF partner unit);	
	c. ANSF-led target/operation (usually no-notice task with TF81 providing	
	cordon, not follow CONOP procedure, 5Ws only);	
	d. Unilateral operation (highly unlikely)	
2.	Check lawfulness of target:	
	a. Intreporting	
	b. JPEL status – check currency, restrictions	
	c. PID – check requirements for PID	
3.	C2 arrangements:	
	a. OEF/OGA – check to ensure that we have separate C2 arrangements	
	b. Afghan involvement – check minimum requirements	
4.	Scheme of Manoeuvre:	
	 a. C2 and detention authority. Ensure we are not detention authority. 	
	b. Reporting requirements.	
5.	If Night Raids, check compliance with Night Raids Directive	
6.	If warning shots need to be considered, include in CONOP process	
7.	ROE (note that JPEL confers automatic PSR(S)1 ROE approval).

10.	Type of operation. Check whether CT other type of operation. Ensure it is an operation that we can do pursuant to our national caveats.

11.	CIVCAS. Check compliance with Directive and initiate investigation.	
12.	Claims. Check whether any payments made for damage or whether any claims are arising out of the operation. Record claims in database and report to IJC LEGAD once claim processed.	
13.	Check detainee details to extent possible.	
14.	Confirm BSHO procedures
