

Guidelines for the public at Inquiry hearings

The following guidelines are provided for members of the public attending hearings of the Government Inquiry into Operation Burnham.

- There is to be no recording of the proceedings. For the avoidance of doubt, this means during the hearing there is to be:
 - o no digital recording either by video or voice recording;
 - no taking of pictures;
 - o no posting of any content to social media.

Notetaking by hand is permitted.

• Members of the public must abide by orders made during the hearing by the Inquiry regarding confidentiality.

Presentations will generally be available on the Inquiry website shortly after delivery.

A full transcript will be published as soon as possible following the hearing.
