SIGNIFICANCE:
OBJ BURNHAM IS THE MOST SENIOR OF THE TWB TB INS NETWORK STILL LOCATED IN AFGHANISTAN, HE HAS CONSIDERABLE EXPERIENCE IN ATKs ON CF AND ANSF. OBJ BURNHAM IS A MENTOR TO THE DEPUTY TBSG OF BAGHLAN PROVINCE. THE REMOVAL OF OBJ BURNHAM WILL HAVE A MEDIUM TO LONG TERM DISRUPTION EFFECT ON THE NETWORK.
OBJ BUS IS A MID LEVEL TWB TB INS COMMANDER WHO HAS RECENTLY RETURNED FROM PAK AT THE DIRECTION OF THE TBSG OF BAMYAN IN ORDER TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE AND LETHAL AID TO OBJ BURNHAM. THE REMOVAL OF OBJ BUS WILL HAVE AN IMMEDIATE DISRUPT EFFECT IN THE PLANNING AND FACILITATION OF ATKs AGAINST CF AND ANSF.

Update On Kalta – 27 Nov

- Commander Abdul KALTA (OBJ BURNHAM) was directly involved in the 2010 IED attack which resulted in the death of Lt Tim O'Donnell.
- It is assessed Abdul KALTA (OBJ BURNHAM) was not directly involved in either of the two Aug 2012 attacks. However, it is assessed that he was involved in the facilitation of personnel and equipment and provided the C2 for personnel involved in those attacks in his role
- Some interesting **Intel** from the KS, reported from ^{PSR(S)1} Three pers were KIA in the initial strike, third to die was KALTA after 20 min of being injured. They sent a per for assistance who was then KIA when the AC130 came back.
- ^{PSR(S)} has a possible broken arm and wounds to his leg. He is seeking medical attention, and INS morale has been devastated. ^{PSR(S)1}
We will focus ISR on ^{PSR(S)} to locate his COI and cue ANSF onto his location in Baghlan if he doesn't go for PAK.
