## **OP BURNHAM:**

Ad hoc memo from intelligence personnel in Afghanistan to superior in New Zealand Paragraph 1:

- Battle damage assessment process can be prolonged.
- Conflicting information is coming from different sources.
- Accuracy of information can be difficult to determine.
- There is confusion in Tala wa Barfek regarding the outcome of the operation.
  Paragraph 2:
- Sources relatively consistent on general location of attack and compounds.
- Wide differences between sources about number and identity of persons killed, including whether persons killed included the targets or civilians.
   Paragraph 3:
- Intelligence often reflects the fact sources have not been able to verify information.
- Some sources sympathise with the targets of the operation and the Taleban. Paragraph 4:
- Conflicting intelligence provides no assurance of accurate picture of the effects of OP BURNHAM in the short term.
- Accurate battle damage assessment can take days, often weeks, and should rely on a range of sources of intelligence to form a true picture.
- Intelligence obtained relating to OP BURNHAM will be issued in formal intelligence reporting.
